- ▶ Every year more than 3,500 Fanshawe students, from 48 different programs, are available for Co-operative Education work semesters in business, industry, government and hospitality sectors.
- ▶ Co-operative Education at Fanshawe is designed to bridge the gap between education and the workplace by integrating academic studies with paid work experience. More than just a job, the co-operative work experience is actually part of the students' program, and their on-the-job performance becomes part of their academic record. That's why Fanshawe Co-op students are highly motivated to perform well in your workplace.
- ▶ Co-op students are looking ahead to careers in organizations like yours. They're eager to apply the skills that they've learned at Fanshawe and make a worthwhile contribution in your workplace. Employers have the opportunity to try out a student's capabilities without obligation or commitment to permanent employment.
- ▶ Normally, students complete two academic semesters before their first co-op. Therefore, you can expect them to come to your workplace with the basic skills you require. Students are available at any time of the year.
- ▶ Work semesters are usually four months, but sometimes students can do an eight month or even a 12 month Co-op. So whatever your timeline, Fanshawe students are likely to be available to meet your needs for skilled temporary employees.
- ▶ Your company may be eligible for a tax credit for each Co-op student you employ.
