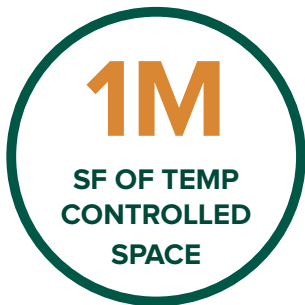

It’s no accident Dr. Oetker chose London for the first-ever expansion out of Germany for its frozen pizza line. The company’s interest in London started in 2009. They were looking to expand their pizza-making line, for the first time, outside Germany. **The LEDC made the business case for London, highlighting the supply chain Dr. Oetker needed from start to finish.** Dr. Oetker needed more than 11 million kilograms of supplies and raw food per year at its London plant - and within a few kilometres’ radius of London are scores of farms that produce all that food, plus multiple fresh water sources. Innovation Park’s dual feeder electrical line on fully-serviced industrial land gave the company the assets they needed, as well as the location near Highway 401 to help get food to the plant and product to the customers. Employing 150 at its London plant, plus 300 spinoff jobs, **the LEDC helped Dr. Oetker get connected to London’s talented workforce of farmers, food scientists, and mechanical engineers.**
