## **Operations Management**

**Graduate Certificate** 



The Operations Management Graduate Certificate Program is a two-semester program designed for university and college graduates. The curriculum focuses on applied knowledge in the field of business operations within a global economy, encompassing the planning and management of operations. This is a companion program to the Graduate Certificate in Logistics and Supply Chain Management, allowing students to complete both certificates in three semesters. Graduates will have the skills and flexibility to apply their knowledge in a variety of leadership and supervisory positions in the service sector, manufacturing, or government.

## **Admission Requirements**

- A two- or three-year College Diploma, or a Degree with minimum "C+" average or cumulative 2.5 GPA or
- Acceptable combination of related work experience and post-secondary education as judged by the College\* or
- Five years of work experience in the operations management field as judged by the College to be equivalent\*

**Note:** \*Applicants may be required to submit a resume and cover letter that includes details of work experience.

### **English Language Requirements**
