
Ritmo y Café is a dance group formed in 2004 in London, Ontario. The mission of @RITMOYCAFE is to share and promote the Latin American folklore.


The Centre for Lifelong Learning at St. Patrick Campus offers free Spanish Classes for children every Saturday.


