THE PORTUGUESE COMMUNITY IN LONDON

The Portuguese Londoners form an important community in the City of London. The 2016 Canada census figures show that 9,855 respondents named Portuguese as their ethnic origin. They have established London as their new home since before 1980 with the largest wave of (3,070) of immigrants arriving in London in the 1950s.

When the Portuguese community first arrived in London, the main clusters were in the Hamilton Street, Highbury area, East London and White Oaks. Today, we find families of Portuguese origin living throughout London.

London is similar to Ontario and Canada with Arabic, Spanish, Mandarin, Portuguese, Italian, German and Cantonese languages all appearing in the top ten non-official languages.
