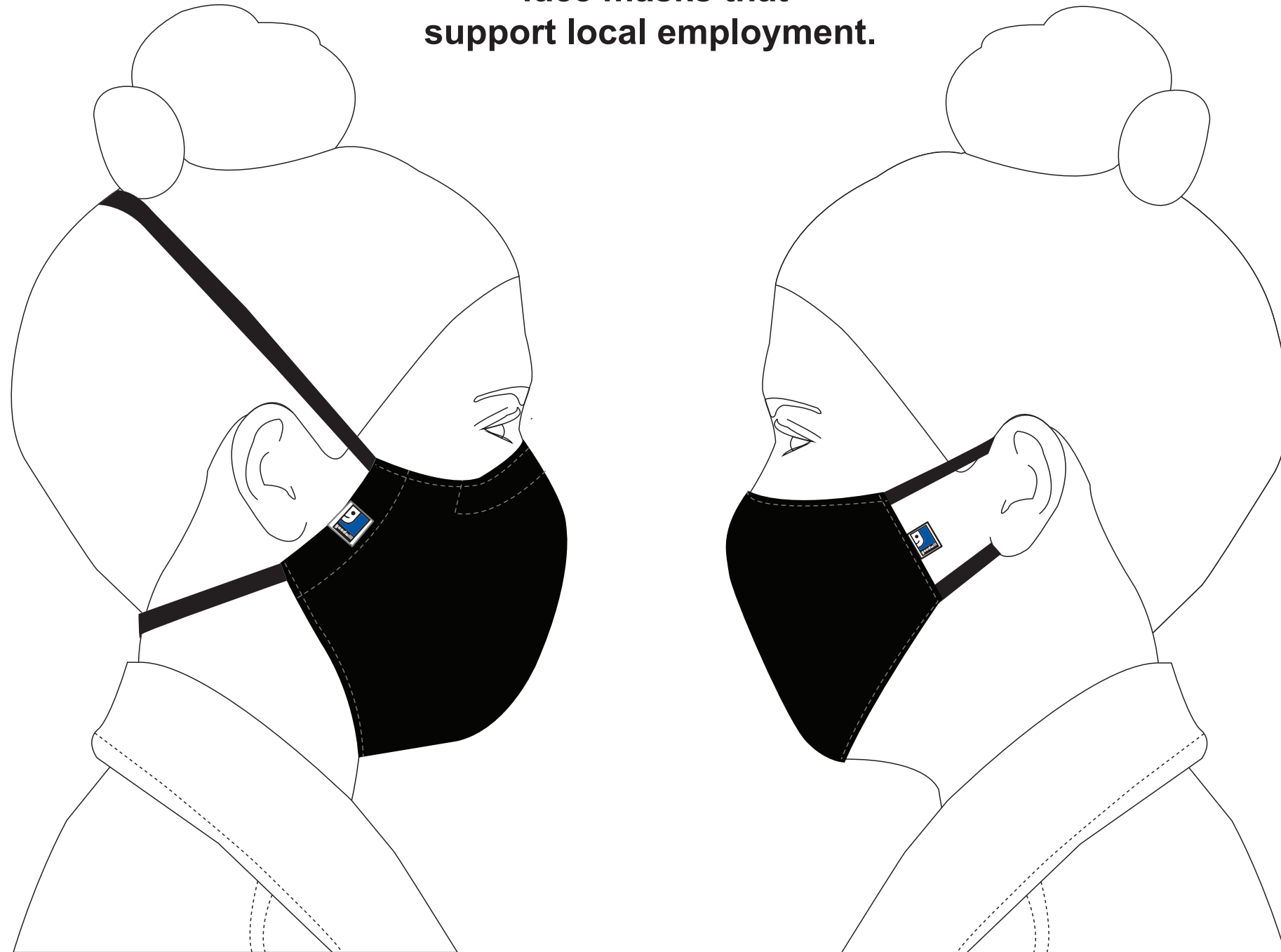

When procuring masks, consider the environmental impact of disposable masks. Reusable masks made out of polyester and polypropylene have an increased environmental impact staying in landfill for up to 200 years. Polyester and polypropylene also contribute to microplastics. Fit is a key factor when considering filtration. Woven fabrics provide superior filtration compared to knit fabrics which when stretched reduce the ability of the mask to filter contaminants.
